Story

Lesson Overview

Materials Needed:

- Notebook or a piece of paper
- Pencil
- Small stones or counters

Activities for Today:

- ★ Sentence Warmup
 - Practice sentence: **"Jungles have tall trees and lots of rain."**
- ★ Mindfulness Exercise
 - Deep breathing exercises
- ★ Sound Workout
 - Sing the ABC Song
 - Practice letter sounds /sh/ and /n/
- ★ Pretend Play
 - Drawing different sizes of circles to form flower seeds.
- ★ Story Time
 - The Wind (an adaptation of a book translated by Rohini Nilekani, original story art by Madhuri Pai and illustrated by Rijuta Ghate)

The learning buddy should:

- Prepare the writing materials.
- Listen alongside the young learner.



- Draw one small circle on a paper.

Note: A Learning Buddy or a grown-up is someone who can help the student during class. There are instructions for learning buddies throughout the lesson. It will be best for the student if a learning buddy can assist them while doing the activities.

Sentence Warmup

The children will be asked to:

- Listen and repeat the practice sentence: **"Jungles have tall trees and lots of rain."**
- Count the number of words in the practice sentence.
- Know what is a jungle and kinds of animals that live in it.
- Present a short acting that shows the practice sentence.
- Answer questions about the animals that live in a jungle.
- Count the syllables of the practice sentence.
- Count the syllables of the word "jungle."

Mindfulness

The children will be asked to:

- Do a deep breathing exercise to help their bodies and minds be calm, relaxed, and ready to learn.

Sound Workout

The children will be asked to:

- Sing along to the ABC song.
- Practice sounding out keywords; "shoulder" and "nurse."
- Practice sounding out the sounds /sh/ and /n/.
- Identify the words that begin with /sh/ and /n/.

Pretend Play

The learning buddy will be asked to:

- Listen alongside the young learner.
- Demonstrate how to do draw different sizes of circles to form flower seeds.
- Answer any questions/clarifications of the young learner.

The children will be asked to:

- Follow the lead of learning buddy in drawing different sizes of circles to form flower seeds.

Story Time

The children will be asked to:

- Imagine what a beach looks like
- Read the story again, "The Wind."
- Identify the different settings of the story.
- Draw settings of the story.
- Share their drawings and retell the story to other family members or friends.
