- D. Predict what will happen in the story;
- E. Draw triangles and rectangles to form various objects; and
- F. Illustrate scenes from the stories they have read.

Story

My First Pair of Shoes – This is an adaptation of a book written by Carole Bloch and illustrated by Rob Owen.

Lesson Overview

Materials Needed:

- Notebook or a piece of paper
- Pencil or markers

Activities for Today:

- ★ Sentence Warmup
 - Practice sentence: **"You wear a hat so you don't get sunburnt."**
- ★ Mindfulness Exercise
 - Balancing exercises
- ★ Sound Workout
 - Sing the ABC Song
 - Practice letter sounds /h/ and /l/
- ★ Pretend Play
 - Draw different sizes of triangles to form tents
- ★ Story Time
 - My First Pair of Shoes (an adaptation of a book written by Carole Bloch and illustrated by Rob Owen)

The learning buddy should:

- Prepare the writing materials.
- Listen alongside the young learner.
- Draw one medium triangle on the page/paper



Note: A Learning Buddy or a grown-up is someone who can help the student during class. There are instructions for learning buddies throughout the lesson. It will be best for the student if a learning buddy can assist them while doing the activities.

Sentence Warmup

The children will be asked to:

- Listen and repeat the practice sentence: **“You wear a hat so you don't get sunburnt.”**
- Count the number of words in the practice sentence.
- Know what does it mean to have a sunburnt.
- Present a short acting that shows the practice sentence.
- Answer questions related to acquisition of sunburnt.
- Count the syllables of the word “sunburnt.”

Mindfulness

The children will be asked to:

- Do a balancing exercise to help their bodies and minds be calm, relaxed, and ready to learn.

Sound Workout

The children will be asked to:

- Sing along to the ABC song.
- Practice sounding out keywords; “hand” and “laptop.”
- Practice sounding out the sounds /h/ and /l/.
- Identify the words that begin with /h/ and /l/.

Pretend Play

The learning buddy will be asked to:

- Listen alongside the young learner.
- Demonstrate how to draw triangles to form tents.
- Answer any questions/clarifications of the young learner.

The children will be asked to:

- Follow the lead of learning buddy in drawing triangles to form tents.

Story Time

The children will be asked to:

- Read the story again, “My First Pair of Shoes.”
- Identify beginning, middle, and ending of the story.
- Draw pictures of the sequence of events of the story.
- Share their drawings to other family members or friends.
